(22 of 1973)

ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES (PETROL) (SUSPENSION) REGULATIONS, 1976

(Published on the 26th March, 1976)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, 1973, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential Supplies (Petrol) Citation (Suspension) Regulations, 1976.

2. The operation of regulation 5 of the Essential Supplies (Petrol) Regulations, 1975, is suspended in its application to competitors in and officials of the Total Transkalahari Road Race whilst so competing or operating in that race —

Suspension of regulation 4 of S.I. 45 of 1975

- (a) on the roads specified in the First Schedule between the hours of 8.00 a.m. on 2nd April, 1976, and 8.00 a.m. on 3rd April, 1976; and
- (b) on the roads specified in the Second Schedule between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. on 3rd April, 1976.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Mogoditshane – Gabane – Kumakwane – Mmankgodi – Manyana – Moshupa – Moshaneng – Mabelane – Selokolela – Letlapana – Diphatana – Ditojana – Marushela – Tubani – Sekoma – Mabutsane – Khakhea – Sekoma.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Sekoma – Takatokwane – Maboane – Lekotsana – down the cut line heading west, south and east of Sekuku coming back on to the main road east of Tshwabi – Mmakgole – Ditshegwane – south towards Mmankgodi – Naledi – Metsae – Moshupa – Tsopane – Thamaga – Kumakwane – Gabane – Mogoditshane.
