**FAUNA CONSERVATION (REPLACEMENT OF NINTH SCHEDULE)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 64A of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Order —
