PENSIONS (CONSOLIDATION) LAW, 1965
(17 of 1965)

PENSIONS (INCREASE) REGULATIONS, 1976

(Published on 26th March, 1976)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Pensions (Consolidation) Law, 1965, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Increase, Regulation and commencement) Regulations, 1976, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st August, 1974.

2. Pensions payable under the Law are increased to the extent shown in the Schedule. Increased pensions

	Exceeding R100 per annum	42 per centum
Awarded on or after 1st October, 1970, but before 1st April, 1974.	Less than R100 per annum	27 per centum
	Exceeding R100 per annum	24 per centum
