**PROTECTED AREA (NORTH EAST DISTRICT AND OTHER AREAS)
ORDER, 1976**

(Published on 21st December, 1976)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by sections 2 and 5 of the Protected Places and Areas Law, 1965, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Area (North East District and Other Areas) Order, 1976. Citation
2. The districts and areas of land specified in the Schedule are declared to be a protected area. Declaration of protected area
3. All police officers are declared to be authorized officers in respect of the protected area declared in paragraph 2. Authorized officers

SCHEDULE

- (a) North East District;
- (b) Francistown District;
- (c) all that land lying within 30 km of the International Boundary between Botswana and Rhodesia commencing at Beacon BP 842 at Kazungula and ending at Beacon BP1 on the boundary between the Central and North East Districts;
- (d) all that land lying within 30 km of the International Boundary between Botswana and Rhodesia commencing at the junction of the Shashe and Ramokgwebana rivers and ending at the junction of the Limpopo and Shashe rivers.
