PROTECTED AREAS (ROAD BLOCKS) REGULATIONS, 1976

(Published on 21st December, 1976)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Protected Places and Areas Law, 1965, the Minister of the Public Service and Information hereby makes the following Regulations —

- Citation **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Protected Areas (Road Blocks) Regulations, 1976.
- Erection of road blocks **2.** For the purpose of exercising the powers conferred on an authorized officer by section 5 (2), a police officer of or above the rank of Assistant Superintendent may cause road blocks to be erected on any road in a protected area, and may stop any vehicle travelling on any such road.
