PREVENTION OF RABIES ACT, 1971  
(48 of 1971)

**RABIES (SELEBI-PIKWE AREA) REGULATIONS, 1976**  
*(Published on the 5th January, 1976)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Prevention of Rabies Act, 1971, the Minister of Agriculture hereby makes the following Regulations

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Rabies (Selebi-Pikwe Area) Citation and Regulations, 1976, and shall apply to the area within a radius of 16 km application of the District Commissioner's Office, Selebi-Pikwe.

**2.** (1) Every person for the time being in charge of a dog shall ensure Dogs to be that such dog is, at all times, either confined

(a) kept confined within a building or other enclosed premises; or

(b) kept on a lead.

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this regulation shall be guilty of an offence.

**3.** (1) Every person for the time being in charge of a dog of or above Dogs to be the apparent age of 4 months shall ensure that such dog is, within 21 days inoculated of the date of publication of these Regulations, inoculated against rabies by or under the supervision of a veterinary officer:

Provided that a dog which has been inoculated since 1st November, 1975, need not be re-inoculated.

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this regulation shall be guilty of an offence.

**4.** (1) No person shall move or permit to be moved any dog out of the Movement of dogs area to which these Regulations apply. prohibited

(2) No person shall move or permit to be moved any dog into the area to which these Regulations apply.

(3) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this regulation shall be guilty of an offence.

**5.** Any person guilty of an offence under these Regulations shall be Penalties liable to a fine of R200 and to imprisonment for 6 months.
