**RECOGNITION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF
CUSTOMARY COURTS (AMENDMENT) NOTICE, 1976**

(Published on 20th August, 1976)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Customary Courts Act upon His Excellency the President, and in pursuance of directions in writing issued under section 36 (1) of the Constitution, His Honour the Vice-President hereby makes the following Notice —

1. This Notice may be cited as the Recognition and Establishment of Customary Courts (Amendment) Notice, 1976. Citation

2. The Recognition and Establishment of Customary Courts Notice, 1972, is amended by substituting for the Second Schedule thereto the new Schedule following — Substitution of Second Schedule to S.I. 68 of 1972

“SECOND SCHEDULE

Key to Jurisdiction of Courts listed in First Schedule

Civil Jurisdiction :

- A. R800 : 10 bovines or equines : 50 sheep or goats
- B. R400 : 5 bovines or equines : 28 sheep or goats
- C. R300 : 4 bovines or equines : 20 sheep or goats
- D. R200 : 3 bovines or equines : 14 sheep or goats

Criminal Jurisdiction :

- E. R400 : 5 bovines or equines : 28 sheep or goats
1 year : 6 strokes
- F. R300 : 4 bovines or equines : 20 sheep or goats
6 months : 4 strokes
- G. R200 : 3 bovines or equines : 14 sheep or goats
6 months : 3 strokes
- H. R100 : 2 bovines or equines : 7 sheep or goats
3 months : 2 strokes.”.
