**REGULATION OF WAGES (GARAGE, MOTOR TRADE AND ROAD
TRANSPORT WAGES COUNCIL) (ESTABLISHMENT) ORDER, 1976**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Regulation of Wages and Conditions of Employment Act, the Minister of Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order —

| Citation | 1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Wages (Garage, Motor Trade and Road Transport Wages Council) (Establishment) Order, 1976. |
| Establishment of Wages Council | 2. There is hereby established a Wages Council (to be known and hereinafter referred to as the "Garage, Motor Trade and Road Transport Wages Council") to perform, in relation to the employees specified in the Schedule, the powers and functions specified on that behalf in the Act. |
| Constitution of the Wages Council | 3. The Garage, Motor Trade and Road Transport Wages Council shall consist, as to independent members, of a Chairman, a Deputy Chairman and one other, and, as to representative members, of not more than two persons to represent employers, and not more than two persons to represent employees. |

SCHEDULE

All persons employed in any undertaking or part of an undertaking which consists of the carrying on, for gain, of one or more of the following activities,

- (a) the actual supply of motor vehicles, agricultural machinery or mobile construction plant; or the repair, servicing assembly or adaption thereof of such vehicles, machinery, or plant on behalf of other persons or undertakings;
- (b) the sale of automotive fuels and lubricants; or
- (c) the road transportation of goods or passengers:

Provided that persons employed in an undertaking or part of an undertaking.

- (i) in any trade affected by a Wages Council Order made under the Act; or
 - (ii) which is operated by the Government,
- shall be excluded.

In this Schedule, "undertaking" includes any person, firms, business, company or club, and the activities of any body whether corporate or incorporate, whether carried on by way of trade or not.
