WATERWORKS LAW, 1961
(26 of 1961)

THAMAGA WATERWORKS AREA DECLARATION, 1976

(Published on the 14th May, 1976)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by sections 3 and 4 of the Waterworks Law, 1961, the Minister of Mineral Resources and Water Affairs hereby declares Thamaga, an area in which an undertaking exists, to be a waterworks area, the boundaries of which are set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Commencing at point "A" (co-ordinate values $Y - 53000 X + 2727500$); the boundary runs eastwards to point "B" ($Y - 56000 X + 2727500$); thence south-eastwards to point "C" ($Y - 57000 X + 2728500$); thence southwards to point "D" ($Y - 57000 X + 2730500$); thence south-westwards to point "E" ($Y - 55500 X + 2731500$); thence westwards to point "F" ($Y - 54000 X + 2731500$); thence north-westwards to point "G" ($Y - 53000 X + 2730000$); thence northwards to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear on Plan KO-12 filed in the Department of Surveys and Lands, Gaborone. The co-ordinates are given in metres on the Lo 25° system.
