**WEIGHTS AND MEASURES (ASSIZE FEES) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1976**

(Published on the 9th April, 1976)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Weights and Measures Act, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations —

Citation **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Weights and Measures (Assize Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1976.

Substitution of Schedules to S.I. 12 of 1972 **2.** The Weights and Measures (Assize Fees) Regulations, 1972, are amended by substituting for the First and Second Schedules thereto the new Schedules following —

WEIGHING INSTRUMENTS

The fee for a self-indicating instrument shall be increased by one hundred per centum. For the purposes of this paragraph, the capacity shall be taken to the nearest 1 000 kg.
