**An Act to authorize the raising by the Government of a loan from the Arab Bank for Economic Development in Africa (BADEA) for the purpose of completing the implementation of the agreement between the Government and Institut Merieux of France, entered into on 12th May, 1978, for the production of foot and mouth vaccine in Botswana.**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the BADEA Production of Foot and Mouth Vaccine Loan (Authorization) Act, 1979. Short title
2. The Minister may raise by loan from the Arab Bank for Economic Development in Africa (commonly known as BADEA and hereinafter referred to as "the Bank"), subject to such terms and conditions as may be agreed between the Minister and the Bank, sums not exceeding in the aggregate the equivalent of US \$2 200 000 (2,2 million United States dollars) for the purpose of completing the implementation of the agreement between the Government and Institut Merieux of France, entered into on 12th May, 1978, for the production of foot and mouth vaccine in Botswana. Authorization to raise loan
3. All sums required to repay the loan authorized to be raised by this Act and to pay the interest and other charges thereon shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Fund. Loan charged upon Consolidated Fund

4. The proceeds of the loan authorized to be raised by this Act shall be paid into the Development Fund.

Powers of  
Minister

5. The Minister is hereby empowered to sign on behalf of the Government any agreements embodying the terms and conditions of the loan as agreed in accordance with section 2, and to authorize any public officer to sign such agreements, and to do all such things as may be necessary or expedient to effect or facilitate such loan or such agreements.

6. As soon as practicable after the raising of the loan, the Minister shall present a paper to Parliament containing a report on the loan and setting out the terms and conditions of the loan and any further information relating thereto that he may consider it appropriate to include.
