ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana

1. This Act may be cited as the Control of Goods (Amendment) Act, 1979, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 19th January, 1979.

2. Section 3 (2) of the Control of Goods Act is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraphs (d) and (e) thereof of the following new paragraphs —

- “(d) the imposition of a levy on such items of goods as may be specified and the manner of utilizing such levy;
- (e) the detention of and forfeiture to the Government of any goods in respect of which an offence under such regulations may have been committed; or
- (f) any incidental and supplementary matters for which the Minister thinks it expedient for the purposes of the regulations to provide, including in particular the entering and inspection of premises to which the regulations relate by persons authorized in that behalf by the Minister with a view to securing compliance with the regulations.”.
