**An Act to make sundry minor amendments in the Laws of Botswana**

*Date of Assent:* 15.8.79.

*Date of Commencement:* 24.8.79.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 2) Act, 1979. Short title
2. The Electoral Act is hereby amended — Amendment of Cap. 02:07
  - (a) in section 33 (1) thereof, by substituting for the words "P50", wherever they appear therein, the words "P100";
  - (b) in section 80 thereof, by substituting for the words "P1 000", which appear therein, the words "P2 000"; and
  - (c) in paragraph 5 of Form N in the Schedule thereto, by substituting for the words "P50", wherever they appear therein, the words "P100".
3. Section 303 (1) of the Criminal Procedure and Evidence Act is hereby amended by substituting for the words "P60", wherever they appear therein, the words "P200". Amendment of Cap. 08:02
4. Section 16 (5) of the Agricultural Resources Conservation Act is hereby amended by substituting for the words "Conservation orders and conservation regulations may — "; which appear Amendment of Cap. 35:06

therein, the words "Notwithstanding the provisions of section 19, conservation orders and conservation regulations may —".

5. The Trading Act is hereby amended —

(a) in section 45 (1) thereof, by the insertion, immediately after paragraph (f), of the following new paragraph —

"(g) Botswana Defence Force                      any goods sold to members of the Botswana Defence Force in a canteen or mess established by the Force."; and

(b) in paragraph 12 of the First Schedule thereto, by the insertion, immediately after subparagraph (3) (b), of the following new subparagraph —

"(c) a canteen or mess established by the Botswana Defence Force."

6. Section 4 (2) of the Liquor Act is hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after paragraph (d) thereof, of the following new paragraph —

"(e) to the sale of intoxicating liquor, from a canteen or mess established by the Botswana Defence Force, to members of the Force."
