

An Act to make sundry minor amendments in the Laws of Botswana

Date of Assent: 18.4.79

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana

1. This Act may be cited as the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1979. Short title
2. The Fourth Schedule to the Tribal Land Act is amended by the substitution of the new Schedule following — Amendment of Fourth Schedule to Cap. 32:02

FOURTH SCHEDULE

KGALAGADI TRIBAL AREA

Commencing at Twee Rivieren on the Nossop River, being the international boundary between South Africa and Botswana, the boundary runs eastwards and north-eastwards along the southern and southeastern boundaries of the Gemsbok National Park; thence eastwards, northwards and westwards along the southern, eastern and northern boundary of the Mabuasehube Game Reserve; thence west-northwestwards along the northern boundary of the Gemsbok National Park to its intersection with the Botswana/Namibia international boundary; thence northwards along the said boundary to its intersection with the parallel of Latitude which passes through Beacon B of Diagram S.G. No. 26/29 of farm No. 2-LO;

thence eastwards along the said parallel of Latitude to its intersection with the north-western corner of the Bakwena Tribal Territory; thence southwards along the said western boundary, the western and southern boundary of the Bangwaketse Tribal Territory, and western boundaries of the Molopo Farms to its intersection with the Molopo River, being the Botswana/South Africa international boundary; thence generally westwards, southwestwards and westwards along the Molopo River to its intersection with the Nossop River; thence northwards along the Nossop River to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear edged red on Plan BP-182(c) filed in the Department of Surveys and Lands.”.

Amendment
of Cap. 44:02

3. Sections 2, 3 (b) and 5 (4) of the Mines, Quarries, Works and Machinery Act are amended by substituting for the words “Senior Government Mining Engineer”, wherever they appear therein, the words “Principal Government Mining Engineer”.

Amendment
of Cap. 61:04

4. The Veterinary Surgeons Act is amended –

(a) in section 7 thereof, by the deletion of subsection (3);
(b) by the deletion of section 12 thereof; and
(c) in section 13 thereof, by substituting for subsection (3) the new subsection following –

“ (3) For the purpose of satisfying himself that a veterinary surgeon has ceased to practise veterinary surgery in Botswana the Chairman shall notify in writing such veterinary surgeon of his intention to remove his name from the register, which notice shall be forwarded to the address recorded in the register, or to any later address of which the Chairman has knowledge or notice, of the said veterinary surgeon.”.
