SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Commerce and Industry by section 3 of the Control of Goods Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

| Citation                               | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Petroleum Products) (Levy) Regulations, 1979.  |
| Levy on petroleum products             | 2. Every person who sells, by retail, whether in person or through an agent, servant or employee, —<br>(a) any petroleum product specified in the Schedule in any quantity, or any illuminating paraffin in quantities of more than 750 ml, shall pay a levy at the rate of 18,45 thebe per litre of the product or paraffin so sold; or<br>(b) any illuminating paraffin in quantities of 750 ml or less shall pay a levy at the rate of 14,00 thebe per 750 ml of the paraffin so sold. |
| Levy to be paid into Equalization Fund | 3. The levy required in terms of regulation 2 shall be paid to the Government, to the credit of the Equalization Fund with the Accountant-General, at the beginning of each month following the month of collection of such levy.   |
