ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Restrictions on exportation of sugar

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Commerce and Industry by section 3 of the Control of Goods Act, the following Regulations are hereby made—

Citation 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Sugar Exportation) Regulations, 1979.

Restrictions on exportation of sugar 2. (1) Subject to the provisions of this regulation, no person shall export per month, to the Republic of South Africa, sugar in quantities exceeding 25 kg except under and in accordance with an export permit issued by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry.

(2) A permit issued in accordance with this regulation shall not allow any person to export per month sugar in quantities exceeding 100 kg.
