SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 57A. (1) of the Customs and Excise Duty Act, the Minister of Finance and Development Planning hereby makes the following Order –

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Provisional Charge to Anti-Dumping Duty) Order, 1979.

Imposition of provisional charge to anti-dumping duty 2. A provisional charge to anti-dumping duty of 22 Units of Account each is imposed for a period of three months on imported goods of the kind specified in the Schedule, as from the date of publication of this Order:

Provided that this Order shall not extend to any goods entered under any item specified in Schedule No. 3 or 4 (other than item 401:00) to the Act.

SCHEDULE

(para. 2)

Journal roller bearings of the rotating end-cover type, with or without end-cover assembly, with an outside diameter of not less than 170 mm but not exceeding 210 mm, commonly used on the axles of railway rolling stock and locomotives, classified under subheading No. 84.62.25.20 of Part 1 of Schedule No. 1 to the Act, and supplied by Brenco Incorporated of Petersburg, Virginia, United States of America.
