**SCHEDULE**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 26 (1) (c) of the Precious and Semi-Precious Stones (Protection) Act, the Minister of Mineral Resources and Water Affairs hereby makes the following Order –

1. This Order may be cited as the Jwaneng Precious Stone Security Area Order, 1979. Citation
2. The area specified in the Schedule is hereby declared to be a precious stone security area. Declaration of precious stone security area

**SCHEDULE**

(para. 2)  
Commencing at a point A, the co-ordinates of which are  $y + 30422,66$   $x + 2719869,30$ , the boundary runs in a north-westerly direction to a point B, the co-ordinates of which are  $y + 36551,45$   $x + 2714726,83$ ; thence in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to a point C, the co-ordinates of which are  $y + 30123,22$   $x + 2707065,93$ ; thence in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to a point D, the co-ordinates of which are  $y + 23994,65$   $x + 2712208,47$ ; thence in a south-westerly direction to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear from Plan No. KN-3 deposited with the Director of Surveys and Lands, Gaborone; the co-ordinates of points A, B, C and D are expressed in metres on Trigonometrical System Lo 25°.
