| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential Supplies (Petrol) (Extension of Hours of Sale) Regulations, 1980. |
| Inter-pretation | 2. In these Regulations — “petrol” includes any mixture of petrol with any other substance capable of being used as a fuel in internal combustion engines; “re-seller of petrol” means a person who operates premises in respect of which a petrol filling station licence has been issued under the Trading Act. |

| Extension of hours of sale of petrol in Gaborone S.I. 25 of 1979 | 3. In addition to the hours specified in regulation 3 (1) of the Essential Supplies (Petrol) Regulations, 1979, a re-seller of petrol with premises situated within Gaborone Township may sell petrol at, in or from those premises between 6 a.m. and 12 noon on Sunday, 18th May, 1980. |
