**ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS**

**REGULATION**

1. Citation
2. Suspension of S.I. 37 of 1979

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on His Excellency the President by section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential Supplies (Speed Limit) (Suspension) Regulations, 1980.

2. The operation of the Essential Supplies (Speed Limit) Regulations, 1979, is suspended in their application to competitors in and officials of the 1980 IGI Botswana Transkalahari Road Race whilst competing or officiating in that race —

- (a) on the roads specified in the First Schedule between 6 a.m. on 16th May, 1980, and 8 a.m. on 17th May, 1980; and
- (b) on the roads specified in the Second Schedule between 6 a.m. and 8 p.m. on 17th May, 1980.
