ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Director of Veterinary Services by sections 4 and 5 of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1977, (9 of 1977), this Order is hereby made.

1. This Order may be cited as Foot and Mouth Disease Control Order, Citation 1980.

2. The area of Central District, east of the Central Ngwato Cordon, and the whole area of the North East District are hereby declared to be infected areas as regards foot and mouth disease. Declaration of infected area

3. Any person who owns or is in charge of cattle in an area declared to be infected with foot and mouth disease shall present such cattle for vaccination against foot and mouth disease at such a time and place as may be directed by an officer of the Department of Veterinary Services. Cattle to be vaccinated

4. No person shall, in any area declared to be an infected area, move any bull, cow, ox, heifer, calf, sheep, goat and pig more than 16 kilometres from the place where such animals is normally kept, kraaled or watered: Restriction on movement of animals

Provided that where an animal is kept in a fenced farm, it shall not, without the prior written consent of the Director, be moved from such area on such conditions as may be specified by the Director.

5. Any person who fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order shall be guilty of an offence. Penalties
