IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on His Excellency the President by section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential Supplies (Speed Limit) (Suspension) Regulations, 1981. |
| Suspension of S.I. 37 of 1979 | 2. The operation of the Essential Supplies (Speed Limit) Regulations, 1979, is suspended in their application to competitors in and officials of the Toyota Desert Race whilst competing or officiating in that race —
(a) on roads within the area the boundary of which is described in the First Schedule between 11.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on 4th June, 1981; and
(b) on the roads specified in the Second Schedule between 8.00 a.m. on 5th June, 1981, and 7.00 p.m. on 6th June, 1981. |

FIRST SCHEDULE

(reg. 2 (a))

Commencing at Mogoditshane, the boundary runs along the Mogoditshane-Gabane road to Gabane; thence approximately northwestwards to the Metsemotlhaba River; thence along the course of the Metsemotlhaba River to the old Gaborone-Molepolole road; thence along the old Gaborone-Molepolole road to Mogoditshane, being the point of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE

(reg. 2 (b))

Mogoditshane — Metsemotlhaba River — Thamaga — Moshupa — Moshaneng — Selokolela — Old Cattle Trek Route — Seherelele Pan — Naledi Valley — Komaku Pan — point west and south of Jwaneng Township — Lobutse Hill — Lehoko — Maokane — Nhane — Bonyanaogo Borehole — 5 lane highway — Lehoko — point west and south of Jwaneng Township.
