REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of regulation 24A of S.I. 55 of 1977

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 35 of the Public Service Act, the following Regulations are hereby made –

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service (Amendment) Regulations, 1981. Citation

2. Regulation 24A of the Public Service Regulations, 1977, is hereby amended by substituting for subregulation (3) thereof, the following new subregulation – Amendment
of regulation
24A of
S.I. 55 of
1977

“(3) Where, after enquiring into an allegation, a disciplinary authority forms the view that a more severe punishment should be imposed, he shall not impose any punishment but shall transmit the findings and other relevant documents to the Permanent Secretary who may –

- (a) impose such punishment as he thinks fit, or
- (b) where he considers the offence serious enough, remit the case to the responsible officer.”
