1. Short title
2. Insertion of section 9A in Cap. 61:01

An Act to amend the Legal Practitioners Act

Date of Assent: 7.5.82.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Act, 1982. Short title

2. The Legal Practitioners Act is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 9 thereof, the following new section — Insertion of section 9A in Cap. 61:01

Enrolment of Botswana qualified to practise in Commonwealth countries

“9A. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 8 and 9, a citizen of Botswana may be enrolled as an advocate or attorney, as the case may be, if he satisfies the Committee that he is qualified to practise as an advocate or attorney in any Commonwealth country having a sufficiently analogous system of law and that his qualifications are such as to render him suitable for enrolment and fulfils such conditions, whether as to status or proficiency, as may be prescribed.”
