1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1980/81) Act, 1982. Short title

The Consolidated Fund is hereby charged with a further sum of P55 013 034 (fifty-five million, thirteen thousand and thirty four pula) to meet expenditure incurred during the financial year which ended on 31st March, 1981, in excess of the amount already appropriated for the services for that year, according to the particulars set out in the Schedule.
