**PARAGRAPH**

1. Declaration of persons not being non-citizens
2. Non-application of Order

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Home Affairs by section 2 of the Employment of Non-Citizens Act, 1981, this Order is hereby made —

1. The persons listed in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared not to be non-citizens for the purposes of the Non-Citizens Act, 1981.
2. This Order shall not apply to a spouse or a dependent of any person specified in this Schedule.
