SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 4 (1) and (2) (a) of the Diplomatic Immunities and Privileges Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Diplomatic Immunities and Privileges (Conferment of Immunities and Privileges on Certain Organizations) Order, 1983, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1973. Citation and commencement
2. The organizations specified in the Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the scheduled organizations") are hereby designated for the purposes of section 4 of the Act or that section is otherwise hereby applied thereto. Application of section 4 of Act to schedule organizations
3. Each of the scheduled organizations shall have all the immunities and privileges set out in Part I of the Second Schedule to the Act and shall also have the legal capacities of a body corporate. Scheduled organizations to have certain immunities and privileges and legal capacities of body corporate
4. The Diplomatic Immunities and Privileges (Designation of Organizations and Conferment of Immunities and Privileges) Order is hereby revoked. Revocation of Cap. 39:01 (Sub. Leg.)
