IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Works and Communications by section 2 of the Public Roads Act, the following Notice is hereby given —

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| 1. This Notice may be cited as the Establishment and Proclamation of the Gaborone-Tlokweng Gate Road Notice, 1983. | Citation |
| 2. The Gaborone-Tlokweng Gate Road, the general course and situation of which are more fully described in the Schedule hereto is hereby established and proclaimed to be a public road. | Establishment and proclamation of Gaborone-Tlokweng Gate road |
| 3. The width of the road referred to in paragraph 2 shall be 30, 5 metres from either side of the centre line of the made surface. | Width of road |

SCHEDULE

Commencing at the intersection of Lobatse Road and Machel Drive in the Gaborone Township, thence generally eastwards and northeastwards along Machel Drive to the intersection thereof with Kaunda and Mobutu Drives and Tlokweng Road; thence generally south-eastwards, eastwards and through the Batlokwa Tribal Territory to the point of intersection with the boundary between Botswana and the Republic of South Africa at Tlokweng Gate, as shown on Plan BP-233 deposited with the Director of Surveys and Lands, Gaborone.	South East	31.3
