ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Inserting of regulation 6A in Meat Inspection etc. Regulations
(Cap. 36:03 Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 3 of the Livestock and Meat Industries Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Meat Inspection and Control of Public Abattoir and Export Slaughter House (Amendment) Regulations, 1983. Citation
2. The Meat Inspection and Control of Public Abattoirs and Export Slaughter House Regulations are hereby amended by inserting immediately after regulation 6 thereof, the following new regulation — Insertion of regulation 6A in Meat Inspection etc. Regulations (Cap. 36:03 Sub. Leg.)
"Prohibition of admitting sick animals 6A. (1) Any animal showing clinical signs of illness of any kind shall not be allowed to enter Botswana Meat Commission's abattoir at Lobatse.
(2) Where any live animal within the premises of the Botswana Meat Commission's abattoir at Lobatse shows any sign of illness of any kind, such animal shall not be slaughtered but shall be destroyed forthwith and the carcass disposed of in the bye-products plant at the abattoir."
