IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Home Affairs by section 8 of the Regulation of Wages and Conditions of Employment Act, the following Order is hereby made —

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Wages (Manufacturing, Service and Repair Trades) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1983.

Amendment of paragraph 3 of S.I. 106 of 1980 2. Paragraph 3 of the Regulation of Wages (Manufacturing, Service and Repair Trades) Order, 1980, is amended by substituting for all the words before the proviso thereto the words "There shall be paid to every employee a basic minimum wage of 48t per hour, except that a person employed in the undertaking or part of an undertaking in question solely to watch over any property of or in the possession of the undertaking or that part of an undertaking, as the case may be, shall be paid a basic minimum wage of 37t per hour:".
