CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DUTY ACT
AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES (NO. 59) NOTICE, 1985
(Published on 27th September, 1985)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by sections 50 and 51 of the Customs and Excise Duty Act, the Schedules to the Act are amended to the extent set out in the Schedule hereto and the said amendment shall come into force on 7th October, 1985.

SCHEDULE

Schedule No. 1 to the Act

Insert new Part 7 as follows:-

“Part 7
ADDITIONAL CUSTOMS DUTIES

NOTES:

1. Any duties specified in this Part in respect of any goods imported into Botswana from places within or outside the common customs area shall be payable at the time of entry for home consumption of such goods.

2. Any duties specified in this Part shall be payable in addition to any duties specified in Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4 of this Schedule and in Schedules 2 and 3.

3. For the purpose of calculating the amount of any ad valorem duty specified in this Part, the value for additional duty shall be deemed to be the value for customs duty purposes as defined in section 69, to which shall be added —

- (i) the cost of all charges in respect of transport and insurance of goods concerned to the place of entry into Botswana; and
- (ii) the amount of any customs, fiscal, excise or sales duties or surcharge paid or leviable on such goods under Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4 of this Schedule and under Schedules 2 and 3.
