SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Home Affairs by section 57 of the Apprenticeship and Industrial Training Act the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Advisory Board for Apprenticeship and Industrial Training (Appointment of Members) Regulations, 1985, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 5th August, 1985. Citation and commencement

The persons whose names are specified or who hold the offices designated in the first column of the Schedule hereto are hereby appointed as members of the National Advisory Board for Apprenticeship and Industrial Training for the period specified in the corresponding entry in the second column of the said Schedule.
