IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Works and Communications by section 127 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1985. Citation

2. The Road Traffic Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”) are hereby amended by substituting for regulation 5 thereof the following new regulation — Substitution

5. The registration number of a motor vehicle or trailer allocated in terms of section 6 (5) of the Act shall include the letters indicating, in accordance with the Third Schedule, the place where the vehicle or trailer is registered or the category to which it belongs, together with a number and a letter assigned to the vehicle or trailer by the licensing officer.”.

3. Regulation 6 (1) of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by substituting for paragraphs (l) and (m) thereof the following new paragraphs — Amendment

“(l) the space between the last letter of the letters indicating, in accordance with the Third Schedule, the place where the vehicle or trailer is registered or the category to which it belongs and the first numeral and the space between the last numeral and the letter assigned to the vehicle or trailer by the licensing officer shall not be less than 25 mm;

(m) where the letters indicating, in accordance with the Third Schedule, the place where the vehicle or trailer is registered or the category to which it belongs and the number and the letter assigned to the vehicle or trailer by the licensing officer are on separate lines, the space between the upper and lower lines shall not be less than 10 mm; and

(n) every plate shall conform generally with one of the forms set out in the Fourth Schedule”.
