

An Act to amend the Botswana Meat Commission Act

Date of Assent: 21.4.86

Date of Commencement: 25.4.86

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Botswana Meat Commission (Amendment) Act, 1986. Short title
2. Section 2 of the Botswana Meat Commission Act (in this Act referred to as the "principal Act") is hereby amended — Amendment of section 2 of Cap. 74:04
 - (a) by inserting immediately before the definition of the word "Commission" the definition of the following new word —
" 'Chairman' means an Executive Chairman appointed under paragraph 2 (1) of the Schedule hereto;";
 - (b) by substituting for the definition of "financial year" which appears therein the following new definition —
" 'financial year' means a period of twelve months ending on 30th September in any year or on such other day as the Commission may determine;";
 - (c) by deleting the definition of the word "trust" which appears therein.
3. The principal Act is hereby amended by substituting for the word "President" wherever it appears in any of the following sections, the word "Minister", namely sections 4, 6, 9, 10, 12 and 21. Amendment of section 4, 6, 9, 10, 12 and 21 of principal Act
4. Section 9 of the principal Act is hereby amended by substituting for paragraph (b) of subsection (4) thereof, the following new paragraph — Amendment of section 9 of principal Act

“(b) an outlay of capital account exceeding P500 000 in any single programme or related group of programmes, in respect of works outside the towns in which the Commission owns an abattoir or other property; or”.

Amendment
of section 15
of principal
Act

5. Section 15 of the principal Act is hereby amended —

(a) by substituting for the words “Stabilization Fund” wherever they appear in the section, the words “Stabilization Reserve”;

(b) by substituting for the word “Fund” which appears at the end of subsection (1) thereof, the word “Reserve”; and

(c) by substituting for subsection (3) thereof the following new subsection —

“(3) Moneys in the Stabilization Reserve shall not at any time exceed the sum of P15 000 000 or such higher sum as the President may by order from time to time approve.”.

Amendment
of section 16
of principal
Act

6. Section 16 of the principal Act is hereby amended by substituting for the amount of “P1” which appears in the proviso to subsection (1) thereof, the amount of “P2”.

Amendment
of section 21
of principal
Act

7. Section 21 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word “cattle” appearing in subsection (1) thereof, the words, “or edible products from cattle”.

Amendment
of Schedule
to principal
Act

8. The Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended —

(a) in paragraph 2 thereof by substituting for subparagraph (1) therein, the following new paragraph —

“(1) The Commission shall consist of a Chairman who shall be an Executive Chairman and ten other members who shall be appointed by the President by instrument in writing in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph.”;

(a) by substituting for paragraphs 9 to 11 thereof the following new paragraphs —

“Executive
Chairman

9. The Executive Chairman appointed under paragraph 2 (1) shall be the chief executive officer of the Commission and shall, subject to the instructions of the Commission, manage the undertakings, operations, property of the Commission and exercise such of the powers of the Commission as the Commission may from time to time delegate to him.

Officers,
servants and
agents

10. The Commission shall, subject to the provisions of this Act, appoint such officers, servants and agents as it may deem necessary for the proper discharge of its functions under this Act on such terms and conditions as it may determine.

Pensions etc.

11. (1) The Commission may, with the approval of the Minister, make provision for the payment on the death, injury or retirement of any of its officers, servants or agents of pensions, gratuities or like benefits to them or to others by reference to their service or otherwise.

(2) Such provision may be made either by contributory or by non-contributory arrangements or partly by the one and partly by the other.

(3) In this paragraph "officers" includes the Executive Chairman."
