AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES (NO. 46) NOTICE, 1986
(Published on 18th December, 1986)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by sections 50 and 51 of the Customs and Excise Duty Act, the Schedules to the Act are amended to the extent set out in the Schedule below.

NOTE. The effect of this notice is that cotton seed oil, sunflower seed oil, groundnut oil, soya bean oil, olive oil and rape seed oil, crude, are exempted from the payment of surcharge.
