IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Director of Veterinary Services by section 4 of the Disease of Animals Act, the following Order is hereby made —

| Citation | 1. This Order may be cited as the Declaration of Rabies (Kweneng and Kgalagadi Districts) Infected Area Order, 1986. |
| Declaration of infected areas | 2. The following areas are hereby declared to be infected with rabies —
(a) Kweneng District;
(b) Kgalagadi District. |
| Inoculation of dogs in infected areas | 3. The owner of any person in charge of a dog of or above the apparent age of 4 months shall, within 21 days, of the coming into operation of this Order ensure that such dog is inoculated against rabies by or under the supervision of the Veterinary officer:
Provided that the provision of this paragraph shall not apply to a dog which has been inoculated within 60 days immediately before the coming into operation of this Order. |
| Isolation of infected dogs | 4. The owner or any person in charge of a dog in an infected area shall ensure that such dog is isolated from other dogs by being kept at all times, either confined within a building or other enclosed premises or on a lead. |
| Destruction of dogs kept in isolation | 5. Any dog which has not been isolated in accordance with the provision of paragraph 4 shall be deemed to have been in contact with or exposed to the disease of rabies and shall be destroyed in accordance with the provisions of section 12 of the Act. |
| Restriction as to movement of dogs in infected area | 6. No person shall without the permission of the Director of Veterinary Services or his representative move any dog into or out of the infected area. |
