**ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS**

**REGULATION**

1. Citation
2. Amendment of regulation 5

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 4 of the Pensions Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation            1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Regulations, 1986.

Amendment of regulation 5        2. Regulation 5 of the Pensions Regulations is amended by the addition after subsection (3) thereof of the following new subsections —

“(4) Where a public officer resigns from the public service after he has served a minimum of 20 years continuous service but does not qualify for a pension under regulation 4 because he has not reached the age of 45 years at the time of his retirement, he shall nevertheless be entitled to a gratuity equivalent to five weeks salary for every completed year of service subject to a maximum of two years salary”
