ARRANGEMENT OF RULES

RULE

1. Citation and commencement
2. Amendment of Order 56 of S.I. 117 of 1969

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Chief Justice by section 26 (c) of the High Court Act, the following Rules are hereby made —

1. These Rules may be cited as the Rules of the High Court (Amendment) Rules, 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st March, 1986.

2. Order 56 of the Rules of the High Court is amended by inserting immediately after rule 10 thereof, the following new rule —

“11. In an undefended civil cause an attorney may without tendering any bill of costs for taxation recover from the party against whom an order for costs has been made a sum not exceeding P350 as costs in that cause:

Provided that —

- (a) the costs claimed do not exceed P350; or
- (b) the said party does not apply to the master to have the bill taxed; or
- (c) the Court does not otherwise direct.”.
