ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Amendment of Schedule to Cap. 40:02 (Sub-Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Selebi-Phikwe Town Council by Regulation 30 of the Township Regulations and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government and Lands, the following bye-laws are hereby made: —

- Citation            1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Selebi-Phikwe (Abattoir) (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 1986.
- Amendment of Schedule to Cap. 40:02 (Sub. Leg.)        2. The Selebi-Phikwe (Abattoir) Bye-Laws are hereby amended by substituting for the Schedule thereto the following new Schedule —

“SCHEDULE (bye-law 3)

- (a) Use of abattoir for slaughtering, including lairage water, inspection and stamping of meat shall be as follows: —

(b) charges per day for use of freezer —		
Bull, ox, cow, heifer, steer or calf	2,50

Pig	1,50
