ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation and Commencement
2. Establishment of a land board
3. Amendment of Schedule to S.I. 47 of 1973

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 19 of the Tribal Land Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Establishment of Subordinate Land Boards (Amendment) Order, 1987, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April, 1987. Citation and Commencement
2. (1) There is hereby established a Subordinate Land Board to be known as Sefhare Subordinate Land Board. Establishment of a land board
(2) The area of jurisdiction of the Sefhare Subordinate Land Board shall be in respect of the following villages, namely, Sefhare, Seleka, Ramokgonami, Pilikwe, Maape, Moshopa, Matlhakola, Machaneng, Chadibe, Shakwe, Mokobeng and Mhalapitsa.
3. In consequence of the provisions of paragraph 2, the Schedule to the Establishment of the Subordinate Land Boards Order is hereby amended — Amendment of Schedule to S.I. 47 of 1973
 - (a) in the third column by substituting for the villages mentioned therein in relation to Mahalapye Subordinate Land Board referred to in the second column within the Bamangwato Tribal Territory named in the first column, the following villages, namely, Mahalapye, Mookane, Mmaphashalala, Radisele, Dovedale, Kudumatse, Makwate, Tzupswe, Bonwapitse, Palla Road, Tewane and Dibete; and
 - (b) by inserting immediately after the entries relating to the said Mahalapye Subordinate Land Board in the second and third columns, the following new entries in the second and third column respectively —

Sefhare Subordinate
Land Board

Third Column

Sefhare, Seleka, Ramokgonami,
Pilikwe, Maape, Moshupa,
Matlhakola, Machaneng, Chadibe,
Shakwe, Mokobeng and Mhalapitsa.
