ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation

2. Amendment to Schedule of Declaration of Townships Order.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Local Government and Lands by section 2 of the Townships Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This order may be cited as the Declaration of Townships (Amendment) Order, 1991. Citation

2. The Schedule to the Declaration of Townships Order is amended by substituting for paragraphs 3 and 6 thereof the following new paragraphs — Amendment of Schedule to Declaration of Townships Order

“3. Ghanzi Township.

Ghanzi Township comprises the Remainder of the Farm 150—NK as will more fully appear on Plan NK—22 deposited with the Director of Surveys and Lands in Gaborone.”

“6. Lobatse Township.

The boundary of the Township is as follows —

Commencing at the northwestern beacon of Lot 1, Lobatse, the boundary runs generally southeastwards along the northern boundary of the said Lot 1, Lobatse, to the northeastern beacon thereof, being a beacon on the western boundary of the Railway Reserve No. 7—JO; thence southeastwards in a straight line to a beacon lettered “A” on diagram DSL 282/91 being a beacon defining the north western corner of Portion 20 (a portion of portion 2) of the Farm Woodhall 11—JO; thence eastwards in a straight line to a beacon lettered “B” on diagram No. 790/59 being a beacon of Portion 10 of the Farm Woodhall No. 11—JO; thence in a direction generally south east by east in a straight line to a beacon lettered “O” on diagram No. A 4066/1926 being a beacon on the eastern boundary of portion 3 (Christina) of the farm Woodhall 11—JO; thence following the eastern boundary of the said Portion 3 to a beacon lettered “B” on Diagram 227/83 being the northeastern beacon of Lot 3169, Lobatse; thence in a southwesterly direction to beacon “C” of the said Lot 3169, Lobatse, being also the northernmost beacon of Lot 4901, Lobatse lettered “J” on Diagram DSL No. 84/91; thence in a southeasterly direction along the eastern boundary of the said Lot 4901 to beacon “L”; thence in a northwesterly direction to beacon “M” of the said Lot 4901, Lobatse being also the southeastern beacon of Lot 1071, Lobatse lettered “B” on Diagram DSL No. 453/46; thence generally southwestwards along the southern boundary of the said Lot 1071, Lobatse, to the southernmost beacon thereof; thence southwestwards in a straight line to the beacon lettered “G” on Diagram DSL No. 56/74, being a beacon on the northeastern boundary of Lot 1735, Lobatse; thence generally southeastwards, southwestwards and northwestwards along the eastern, southern and southwestern boundaries of the said Lot

1735, Lobatse to the beacon common to the said Lot 1735, Lobatse, the Remainder of the Farm Springfield No. 18—JO and Lot 333, Lobatse; thence generally southwards along the eastern boundaries of Lots 333, 620 and 330, Lobatse, the southeastern boundaries of Lots 330, 620 and 329, Lobatse, and the southwestern boundary of Lot 329, Lobatse to the westernmost beacon of the said Lot 329, Lobatse, being a beacon on the eastern boundary of the Railway Reserve No. 7—JO; thence in a straight line to the southernmost beacon of Lot 322, Lobatse, being a beacon on the western boundary of the Railway Reserve No. 7—JO; thence generally northwards along the western boundaries of the said Lot 322, Lobatse, the southern, western and northern boundaries of Lot 321, Lobatse and the western boundary of Lot 164, Lobatse to the point where the latter boundary intersects the southern boundary of Lot 1, Lobatse; thence generally westwards and northwards along the southern and western boundaries of the said Lot 1, Lobatse, to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear on Plan No. JO—109b deposited with the Director of Surveys and Lands, Gaborone.
