FRANCISTOWN TOWN COUNCIL 1994/1995
RATING BYE-LAWS, 1994
(Published on 12th August, 1994)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 30, as read with regulation 31 of the Town Councils Regulations, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing, the Francistown Town Council hereby makes the following Bye-Laws -

- Citation 1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Francistown Town Council 1994/1995 Rating Bye-Laws, 1994.
- Levy of rates 2. The property rates payable in the Francistown Township for the period 1994/1995 shall be at the rate of —
- (a) 1,36 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for residential purposes, and 5,44 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for residential purposes; and
- (b) 1,61 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for industrial or commercial purposes, and 6,44 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for commercial or industrial purposes.
- When rates due 3. The rates fixed in bye-law 2 shall become due and payable, by the person and payable liable to pay such rates, at the commencement of these Bye-Laws.
