ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of regulation 21
3. Amendment of regulation 48

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 54 of the Local Government (District Councils) Act, the Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Local Councils (Conduct of Elections) (Amendment) Regulations, 1994. Citation

2. Regulation 21 of the Local Councils (Conduct of Elections) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”, is amended by the addition of the following new subregulations — Amendment of regulation 21

“(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of subregulations (1) and (2), if at the end of the period stipulated for the taking of the poll the presiding officer is satisfied that, for reasons beyond their control, many voters would not be able to cast their votes within the stipulated closing time, he may permit the taking of the poll to continue for a further period, not exceeding two hours beyond such closing time.

(4) Any votes cast within the period extended under subregulation (3) shall not be held to be invalid solely on the ground that they were cast during such extended period.”

3. The Regulations are amended by substituting for regulation 48 thereof the following new regulation — Amendment of regulation 48

“Equality of votes 48. Where, after the counting of votes (including any recount) is completed, an equality of votes is found to exist between any candidates, a fresh election shall be held in respect of that polling district.”
