IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 37 of the Tribal Land Act, the Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing hereby makes the following Regulations —

| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Tribal Land (Subordinate Land Boards) (Amendment) Regulations, 1994. |
| Addition of new regulation 3
Cap. 32:09
Sub.leg | 2. The Tribal Land (Subordinate Land Boards) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations", are amended by inserting immediately after regulation 2 thereof the following new regulation —
"Election or appointment of members of subordinate land boards |
| | 3. (1) The membership of subordinate land boards, their election or appointment, and their periods of office shall be as hereinafter provided.
(2) The provisions of subsections (3) and (4) of section land boards 3 of the Act shall apply to members of a subordinate land board as they apply to members of land boards.
(3) The membership of each subordinate land board shall be —
(a) 4 members selected and appointed in accordance with the procedure described in the third column of the First Schedule to the Act, who shall hold office for 4 years, but who shall be eligible for re-selection and re-appointment;
(b) 4 members appointed by the Minister, who shall hold office for 3 years, but who shall be eligible for re-appointment; and
(c) in addition to the members appointed or selected in accordance with paragraphs (a) and (b) there shall be — |

- (i) 1 member representing the Minister of Agriculture;
and
 - (ii) 1 member representing the Minister of Commerce
and Industry.”
3. Regulation 6 of the Regulations is amended —
- (a) in subregulation (1) thereof by inserting immediately after the word “member” in line 3 the word “thereupon”; and
 - (b) by deleting subregulation (3) thereof.
4. Regulation 7 of the Regulations is amended by substituting for subregulation (2) thereof the following new subregulation —
- “(2) The quorum of a subordinate land board shall be half of the number of appointed and elected members thereof, or if such number is an even number, a majority of such members shall constitute a quorum.”
5. The Regulations are amended by substituting for regulation 8 thereof the following new regulation —
- “Chairmen
of boards 8 (1) The members of a subordinate land board shall, each year, and for the ensuing year, elect from their number a chairman, and a deputy chairman who shall act as chairman at any meeting of the board when the chairman is absent.
- (2) At any meeting of a subordinate land board, when the chairman and the deputy chairman are absent, the members present at the meeting shall elect one of their number to act as chairman for that meeting.”
6. Regulation 10(2) of the Regulations is amended by deleting the words “he has any objection to” and by adding immediately after the words “applied for,” the words “will conflict with other peoples’ land rights, or with present land use”.
7. Regulation 11(4) of the Regulations is amended by substituting for the words “not exceeding P10 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month, or to both” the words “of P100 and to imprisonment for three months”.
8. Regulation 12(1) of the Regulations is amended —
- (a) in paragraph (a) thereof by substituting for the word “tribesman” the words “citizen of Botswana”;
 - (b) in paragraph (c) thereof by inserting immediately after the word “available” the words “and whether its size and location are suitable”.
9. Regulation 14(2) of the Regulations is amended by substituting for the words “not exceeding P50 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months” the words “of P100 and to imprisonment for three months”.
10. Regulation 16 of the Regulations is amended in subregulation (6) thereof by substituting for the words “six months” the words “four months”.
