ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by section 12 of the Customary Courts Act, the Attorney-General hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Powers to Prosecute (Authorization) Order, 2003.

2. Members of the Local Police Force are hereby authorized to prosecute in all Customary Courts of Botswana.

3. The authority given in paragraph 2 shall be exercised subject to the directions given by the Attorney-General from time to time.
