SECTION

1. Short title and commencement
2. Amendment of Schedule to Cap. 02:06

An Act to amend the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act

Date of assent: 30th August, 2004

Date of commencement: 1st April, 2004

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances (Amendment) Act, 2004, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April 2004.

Short title and commencement

2. The Schedule to the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act is amended —

Amendment of Schedule to Cap. 02:06

(a) by substituting, for paragraph 1 thereof, the following new paragraph —

“1. Every Member, other than the Attorney-General, shall receive a salary which shall, except in the case of the Government Whip and the Opposition Whip and any other Member, include the responsibility allowance, calculated, in the case of —

- (a) the President, at the rate of P357,132.00 per annum;
- (b) the Vice President, at the rate of P274,716.00 per annum;
- (c) a Minister, other than an Assistant Minister, at the rate of P219,780.00 per annum;
- (d) the Speaker, at the rate of P219,780.00 per annum;
- (e) an Assistant Minister, at the rate of P183,144.00 per annum;
- (f) the Deputy Speaker, at the rate of P183,144.00 per annum;
- (g) the Leader of the Opposition, at the rate of P183,144.00 per annum;
- (h) the Government Whip, at the rate of P152,616.00 per annum;
- (i) the Opposition Whip, at the rate of P148,044.00 per annum; and
- (j) any other Member, at the rate of P138,744.00 per annum.”;

(b) by deleting paragraph 7 thereof.
