An Act to amend the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act (Cap. 02:06)

Date of Assent: 20th December, 2004.

Date of Commencement: 31st December, 2004.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 2004 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 8th October, 2004.

Amendment

2. Paragraph 4 of the Schedule to the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act is amended by substituting for that paragraph, the following new paragraph —

“4. Every Member other than the Attorney-General shall receive an allowance calculated as follows —

at the rate of P60,624 per annum;

(d) for a Specially Elected Member and the Speaker of the National Assembly at the rate of P54,720 per annum.”.
