ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation and commencement
2. Amendment of Cap. 43:08 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Trade and Industry by section 3 of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges (Petroleum Prices) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, and shall come into force on 11th June, 2004. Citation and commencement
2. The Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges (Petroleum Prices) Regulations are hereby amended — Amendment of Cap. 43:08 (Sub. Leg.)
 - (a) in regulation 3(a) (i) thereof, by substituting for the word “43” appearing therein, the word “76”;
 - (b) in regulation 3(a) (ii) thereof, by substituting for the word “32” appearing therein, the word “59”; and
 - (c) by substituting, for the Schedule thereto, the following Schedule —
