ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of regulation 64 of Cap. 21:05 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 178 of the Botswana Defence Force Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence Force (Regular Force) (Officers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2004. Citation

2. The Defence Force (Regular Force) (Officers) Regulations are hereby amended by substituting, for regulation 64 thereof, the following new regulation — Amendment of regulation 64 of Cap. 21:05 (Sub. Leg.)

“Benefits on discharge or dismissal on prescribed grounds

64 (1). An officer who is, under regulation 6 or 7, or under section 67 or section 75 (5)(a) of the Act required to resign, or is cashiered or dismissed from the Force may be paid —

- (a) if his pensionable service amounts to 10 or more years but less than 20 years, such gratuity as the Commander may determine;
- (b) if his pensionable service amounts to 20 or more years, such pension or gratuity as the Commander may determine.

(2) Where the Commander intends to order forfeiture of the pension or gratuity referred to in subsection (1), or both the pension and gratuity, he shall —

- (a) inform the officer of such intention in writing; and
- (b) give the officer reasons for such forfeiture.

(3) Where the Commander gives notice in accordance with subsection (2), the officer may, within 14 days of receipt of such notice, give reasons why such order should not be against him.”.
