ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Prohibition of hunting in controlled area NG 38
Schedule

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Environment, Wildlife and Tourism by section 45 of the Wildlife Conservation and National Parks Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Wildlife Conservation and National Parks (Controlled Hunting Area NG 38) (Hunting Prohibition) Order, 2004.

2. (1) Subject to subparagraph (2), no person shall hunt or disturb any animal in Controlled Hunting Area NG 38, as set out in the Schedule, with effect from 15th November 2004 for a period of twelve months.

(2) Notwithstanding subparagraph (1), any animal may be removed from Controlled Hunting Area NG 38 where the removal is done to protect life or property.

SCHEDULE

CONTROLLED HUNTING AREA NG 38 - DESCRIPTION

Paragraph 2 (1)

Commencing at a point marked NG /9/35/38 (appr. Coord 34E703180N7747840) being the point of intersection between the Maun/Ghanzi road and the thalweg of the Xudum River, indicated by an iron standard set in concrete marked 246;

the boundary follows the said river and the Nhabe River southeastwards (121Y) for app. 1 km to a point marked NG/35/37/38 (app. Coord. 34E704250N7747210), being the point of intersection with the old Maun/Ghanzi road, indicated by an iron standard set in concrete marked 298;

thence follows the said road southwestwards (217Y) for app. 39 km to a point marked NG/9/38/39 (app. Coord. 34E681050N7716170), being the point of intersection with track leading to Sehitwa, indicated by an iron standard set in concrete marked 292;

thence follows the said track northwards (351Y) for app. 21 km to a point marked NG/9/38 (app. Coord. 34E677740N7736370), being the point of intersection between the new Maun/Ghanzi road and the road leading to Shakawe, indicated by an iron standard set in concrete marked 294;

thence follows the Ghanzi/ Maun road northeastwards (66Y) for app. 28 km to the point of commencement.
